### Walk-in

It is nice to see that many parents make use of the walk-in time on Mondays and Fridays, that way you can also see what your child is doing in the group. The walk-in moment lasts from 08.20-08.35. At 08.35 the teachers will start their lessons. Please be so kind to say goodbye in time and leave the school.

## **Getting there on time**

For a nice start to the day, it is important to arrive on time. To still come in when the group is already busy is often not pleasant for a child and it disrupts the lesson. Classes start at 8:30 a.m. and we expect all children to be in class by then. School opens at 8:15 a.m. and the children can then socialize with classmates and wait in the hall. At 8:20 the children may go to class.

If your child eats lunch at home please also make sure your child is back at school on time. Classes start at 1 p.m.

Children who enter school late will be recorded. In case of 4 tardies within 4 weeks, an e-mail will be sent to the parents with a request for improvement. If it happens again after that, a conversation will follow. If the child still fails to arrive on time, the school attendance officer will be called in.

Being late can happen once, but prevention is better.

#### **Treat**

When the children have their birthday they are allowed to treat at school and go around the classes. This is of course very nice. As the teachers also discussed during the parent (after) afternoon, we think it is important that the treat is small and healthy.

## **AVG** consent form

At the parent (after) afternoon you were asked to fill out a consent form for the use of photos, visual material and other personal data of your child(ren). This in the context of AVG (General Data Protection Regulation). If you have not yet completed this form, please do so this week and hand it in to your child's teacher.

## Parents' Association (OV)
